**NORTH WEBSTER TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**

The North Webster Town Council held its regular June meeting at the North Webster Community Center at 6:00pm. Dan Thystrup, Lisa Strombeck and Dave Waliczek were present.

**Minutes**

Dave Waliczek made a motion to approve the May 20, 2025 minutes. Lisa Strombeck seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

**Claims**

Lisa Strombeck made a motion to approve all submitted claims and Dave Waliczek seconded to motion. The claims were approved.

**Appointment of Town Attorney**

Lisa Strombeck made a motion to appoint Laura Kaufman as Town of North Webster attorney as of July 1, 2025. Dave Waliczek seconded and motion was passed.

**Utilities**

Mike Noe of Inframark, provided a written report for the month of June of the current activities of the department pertaining to the storm water system, collection system, buildings, equipment, streets and wastewater plant prior to the meeting.

Mike noted the air flow issue on Lift Station B has been repaired.

Lift Station A needs a new pump. Mike provided a quote for a MINQ pump for \$37,314. 81. It will include noise reduction muffler and cut down on needed upkeep and maintenance. Dave Strombeck made a motion to purchase the new pump. Lisa seconded the motion.

**Police**

Town Marshal, Greg Church, submitted a report of the Police Department for the month of June. He noted the town attorney will be working to amend the tall grass ordinance.

**Parks**

Leann Hubs mentioned that Music in the Park has been running every Friday night at 7pm.
